A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF DELINQUENT TAX PROPERTIES AT A REDUCED PRICE

WHEREAS, Henry County acquires ownership of parcels which were the subject of the annual delinquent tax collection suits when no other bidder bids on a parcel at the Delinquent Tax Sale; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee law allows the Delinquent Tax Committee and County
Mayor to place a fair resale price on each parcel of land purchased by the County at a
delinquent tax sale, and said committee may authorize the sale of any tract of land upon
such terms as will secure the highest and best sale price; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee law requires that no parcel of land purchased by the County at a delinquent tax sale shall be resold for an amount less than the total amount of the taxes, penalty, cost and interest accrued against such parcel, unless the legislative body determines that it is impossible to sell the parcel of land for such amount and grants permission to offer the land for sale at some amount to be fixed by such legislative body; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §5-14-204(5)(A), the Henry County Sheriff's Department requests that all perishable food items purchased in the amount over the threshold of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) be exempt from requiring sealed bids; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Henry County, Tennessee Board of Commissioners, meeting in regular session on this 17th day of May, 2021, a majority or more of the membership concurring, that the Henry County Sheriff's Department is hereby exempt for all purchases of perishable food items from the bid law of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), except as otherwise provided in the County Purchasing Law of 1983, Tennessee Code Annotated § 5-14-201 *et seq*.
