Re: Request to amend the budget for the Henry County Court

Pat:

Our office has had an unusual situation arise which will require the amendment of budget. We have had a divorce case filed where the defendant is deaf and communicates through sign language. While the Tennessee Administrative Office of the Courts has a program which provides and pays for a foreign language interpreter for various civil and criminal court cases, there is no such program which provides these services for individuals who are deaf.

Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 42(3)(a) provides in pertinent part:

- (a) Appointing an interpreter is a matter of judicial discretion. It is the responsibility of the court to determine whether a participant in a legal proceeding has a limited ability to understand and communicate in English. If the court determines that a participant has such limited ability, the court should appoint an interpreter pursuant to this rule.
- (b) Recognition of the need for an interpreter may arise from a request by a party or counsel, the court's own voir dire of a party or witness, or disclosures made to the court by parties, counsel, court employees or other persons familiar with the ability of the person to understand and communicate in English.

Additionally, the Americans with Disabilities Act 42 USC 12131(2) defines a Qualified Individual with Disabilities as "an individual with a disability who, with or without reasonable modifications to rules, policies, or practices, the removal of architectural, communication, or transportation barriers, or the provision of auxiliary aids and services, meets the essential eligibility requirements for the receipt of services or the participation in programs or activities provided by a public entity."

Based on the reading of these laws, it is the county's responsibly to pay for these services to ensure that the litigant may communicate with the Court and have access to participate in all essential court proceedings.

I have spoken with the Administrative Office of the Courts, and the Clerk & Masters in Hardin and Benton County and each have confirmed the responsibility of the county to provide these services.

This is a rare occurrence and is not expected to be a reoccurring annual expense. The interpreter would be required to attend each hearing in the current action. The closest certified sign language interpreter is in Jackson Tennessee, she charges \$60.00 per hour and receives mileage at the rate of 62.5 cents for travel. I am estimating that the costs associated with this matter will not exceed \$1,000.00.

Based on the foregoing, I am requesting that the Henry County Chancery Court Budget, line item 53400-399 be amended to reflect an increase of \$1,000.00 for this year. Should you have any questions regarding this matter, please do not hesitate to contact me.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN HENRY COUNTY AND THE HENRY COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF APPROVED WORK PROJECTS

This Agreement is entered into this 17th day of October, 2022, by and between Henry County, Tennessee (the "County") and the Henry County Highway Department (the "Highway").

WHEREAS, under Tennessee Code Annotated Section 12-9-108, the County and Highway are authorized to contract with one another for the performance of any governmental service, activity or undertaking that each entity is individually authorized by law to perform; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 54-7-202(d) authorizes county highway departments to perform work for other governmental entities as long as such work is first approved by the county legislative body and the highway department is reimbursed for the work; and

WHEREAS, The County Highway Department from time to time receives requests from the County to perform work for the County; and

WHEREAS, It is the intent of the County Legislative Body to authorize the County Highway Department to perform such work for the County General Fund; and

WHEREAS, This Interlocal Agreement is in the best interest of the County and Highway;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1. Prior to the County Highway Department beginning any work project on behalf of the County, the County Mayor or authorized County Official shall submit a written request to the Chief Administrative Officer of the County Highway Department.

Section 2. Upon receiving an official request from the County Mayor or authorized County Official, the Chief Administrative Officer of the County Highway Department shall review the request and scope of work to be undertaken and determine if the County Highway Department will undertake the project.

Section 3. Once the Chief Administrative Officer of the County Highway

Department determines the project should be performed by the Highway, the project may
commence. However, if the total cost of the requested project exceeds \$25,000.00, then the
Chief Administrative Officer of the County Highway Department shall seek separate approval
for the project from the County Legislative Body.

Section 4. The County General Fund shall reimburse the County Highway

Department for all project costs, including materials, supplies, equipment and personnel, and the

County Highway Department shall keep a copy of the written request submitted by the County

and any other such documents related to the project and its costs.

Section 5. This Agreement shall become effective upon passage by the governing body of each party hereto, and shall remain in effect until written notice of termination or amendment is given by either party. The withdrawing party shall give sixty (60) days written notice of intent to terminate.
