Judge Snyder and Jayann:

As requested, attached are the budget forms (FY24 and FY25) that need to be completed for Henry County. There are 3 tabs on the budget forms that you need to complete - Summary, Detail Prg1, and Salaries Prg1. As a reminder, the SBC funds need to be dispersed across the following 4 budget line items:

- 1. Salaries, Benefits, Taxes
- 2. Supplies
- 3. Travel, Conferences, and Meetings
- 4. Specific Assistance to Individuals

If you want to build in cost of living increases for the salaries from FY24 to FY25, please be sure to include that in the FY25 budget. After you complete the two budget forms, please send them to Elizabeth Reeve (included on this email). Her email address is: <u>Elizabeth Reeve@tn.gov</u>. <u>Elizabeth: as a reminder, Henry County needs to change their existing SBC budget - all line items.</u>

Important things to keep in mind as you draft your SBC budget:

- 1. SBC Coordinator is a full time position.
- 2. Supplementing Court Staff salary existing court staff to serve as SBC Supervisor (to be determined by the judge could be judicial assistant, court director, lead YSO, etc.) appropriate amount to supplement their salary based on the role of the court employee assisting with SBC. This includes but is not limited to the following: direct supervision of the SBC Coordinator; entering and tracking all SBC expenses/budgetary requirements; observing and facilitating (as needed) Child and Family Team Meetings when the SBC Coordinator is out sick or on vacation; attending quarterly SBC Stakeholder meetings (aka, Active Community Team Meetings); present for SBC court hearings; and other duties as identified and/or needed.
- 3. If you choose to have a part-time magistrate to hear SBC cases, the amount of time and funding paid from the SBC funds, must be for SBC cases only. SBC cases need to have consistency with the judicial officer. Please keep that in mind as you determine whether or not you are going to have a magistrate for SBC or if you are going to preside over these cases.
